

POLICY GOVERNING INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

I. Students From Foreign Countries Attending ROCORI Schools.

- A. Grade Placement:
Foreign Exchange students will be placed in the appropriate grade level based on age and previous number of years in school attendance. In order to be a senior, the student must have attended eleven years equivalent to our grades one through eleven.
- B. Granting of Diploma/Certificate of Attendance:
 - 1. Student must provide proof of prior years of study and courses completed.
 - 2. Student must meet the same course and credit requirements of other Rocori High School students as outlined in the Rocori Policy for Graduation.
 - 3. Student must be enrolled in at least six (6) credits during the senior year including English and U.S. History.
 - 4. Students in grade twelve who do not meet the academic requirements listed above will be able to go through graduation ceremonies and will be presented a Certificate of Attendance.
- C. Honors:
 - 1. Exchange students will not be ranked in their appropriate grade level.
 - 2. Exchange students will not receive a grade level grade point average.

II. Student from ROCORI attending schools in Foreign Countries.

- A. ROCORI students attending school in a foreign country will be eligible for a Rocori diploma subject to completion of an individualized program approved by the counselors, school principal, students, and parents prior to the student's foreign exchange experience. Options may include but not be limited to:
 - 1. ROCORI coursework completed prior to or during the experience.
 - 2. ROCORI coursework completed after the experience.
 - 3. Other summer course opportunities.
 - 4. Appropriate coursework completed during the experience with the foreign school.
 - 5. Waivers and/or substitutions of ROCORI requirements and competencies.
- B. Student grades and grade point average will be recalculated based on coursework completed at ROCORI.
